

Contrast tomography: upper abdomen - contrasted total abdomen - triphasic - urotomography

REQUIREMENTS AND PREPARATION



### Requirements for the procedure:



Women: inform if you are pregnant or have any suspicions.



Inform if you have a history of allergies or known reactions to contrast media, renal function disorders, diabetes, heart failure or if you are insulin dependent.



The patient must be accompanied by an adult on the day of the exam.



If the patient is a minor, they must be accompanied by an older relative.



The hospitalized patient must bring a canalized vein and a family member of legal age.

# Instructions for preparation:



Fasting for four (4) hours. The previous meal should be light.



Do not stop control medications.



Dialysis patients should discontinue metformin 48 hours before and 48 hours after injection of contrast medium.

#### Documents required for the procedure:



Identification document.



Current order (does not apply to individuals).



Complete Clinical History with data justifying the study.



Resonances, tomographies, ultrasounds and previous studies.



Blood creatinine test not older than one month (30 days).

# Be an hour and a half (1 hour and 30 minutes) before the procedure

This space will be necessary to register your information and confirm the correct preparation for the performance of your procedure.

Exception: if it is a Bone Pelvis, it must be half an hour (30 minutes) before the procedure for administrative procedures
